AARON WISE (-4)

Q. Aaron, good playing today, 4-under 66. What was working well for you out there today?

AARON WISE: Everything, man. It's a tough golf course here this week and I think more importantly, the best thing I'm doing is limiting the bogeys. I have gotten up and down quite a few times and even saved myself from making double a few times. It's really just kind of scrapping it together and putting a score together around here because it's playing super tough.

Q. You were playing later in the day. Did you feel any energy from the fans out there having them out for the first time at a domestic event?

AARON WISE: Absolutely, it's amazing to have them back. Golf was not the same without them and it's super cool and I definitely feed off of that. We only have 2,000 out here so it's not quite the same as a normal event, but it's definitely getting more back to normal. And we love it as players, we're able to feed off it.

Q. And lastly, you put yourself in a good position going into the weekend. What do you need to do well in the final two rounds to give yourself a chance to win?

AARON WISE: Like I said, just keep putting a score together. You've really got to manage yourself, you've got to miss in the right spots, and even if you're having a bad day I feel like you can keep it around even if your short game is sharp and you're thinking well. I'm just going to try to keep doing that, keep obviously figuring out the strategy as this is the first year we've played here. Obviously if I can keep making putts and hitting it well, that's definitely going to help.
