

**ROUND 4 INTERVIEW**  
**November 8, 2020**



**BROOKS KOEPKA (-8)**

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**Q. Brooks, great playing today. If we could just get an opening comment on your round.**

**BROOKS KOEPKA:** Yeah, played good, played good the last two days. It was nice, build some confidence I guess going into Augusta scoring well. The first two days, it's a shame I put in a new driver. Never should have done that, probably cost me the tournament, but at the same time playing well, just got to play well next week.

**Q. You made the turn at 1 over yesterday, really turned it on for your final 27 holes. Was that driver the only thing you were doing differently in that last stretch? What caused you to be able to turn it around so quickly?**

**BROOKS KOEPKA:** Yeah, this golf course, if you're going to drive the ball in the fairway, you're going to have a lot of scoring opportunities. The first two days that driver was terrible, just flat out. I don't know why we switched. If you're going to hit three, four fairways a day, you're going to cost yourself at least three shots. You can't control it around the greens and you put yourself in some weird spots. No, it's a shame. I know I would have won it if I just would have stuck with it.

**Q. Thoughts on the course as a player-consultant, how it turned out throughout the week of competition?**

**BROOKS KOEPKA:** It turned out better than I could have imagined. I love the fact there's so many different options from different tee boxes. You don't always have to play it off the back tee of the back of the tee box, you've got different tee options for different pin locations. You can move holes up, you can lengthen them if you want. There's so many options and that's why I think this place has turned out better than I thought it would.

**Q. Any reviews from other players or did any players throughout the last few days ask you for advice on the course?**

**BROOKS KOEPKA:** No, nobody asked me for advice, but I wouldn't give it up either way.

**Q. How did you feel like this course prepared you for next week going into Augusta?**

**BROOKS KOEPKA:** Just needed to go out and score. I think the greens, how quick they are, it's nice to go into next week. Other than that, it doesn't really resemble Augusta. There's not really much you could use here that you're going to use around Augusta. Augusta's a little bit more lush and the fairways are quite wider, but it is what it is.

**Q. So because you're the birdie leader this week, RSM Birdies Fore Love, Davis Love's foundation from RSM are going to do a \$50,000 to the charity of your choice. So can you just speak about what a great honor that is, first of all?**

**BROOKS KOEPKA:** Yeah, no, anytime you lead birdies for the week, you know you're doing something nice. It's nice what RSM and Davis are doing. I think it's special to help guys out here on the Tour give back. That's a big thing for us is always giving back and the Tour's done a good job of that and I think all of the players have.

**Q. Do you have an idea of who that money might go to?**

**BROOKS KOEPKA:** Yeah, it will go to my foundation.
