

**PAUL BROADHURST ( -15, lost 9<sup>th</sup> playoff hole)**

**Q. What a way to finish the year. Take us through this morning.**

**PAUL BROADHURST:** It's obviously a lot colder so the holes are playing a little bit different; 17's playing a lot longer than it was when we finished last night. Instead of a wedge, it was a good 8-iron. Kevin hit the shot on the ninth extra hole, he hit a great shot into a couple of feet. I thought I hit a good shot, but it just hung up in the cold breeze and came up a yard short. Another yard it might have been 10 feet. It was a good playoff. There's nothing I can do about that. I'm proud of the way I played all week and, you know, Kevin won and that's fair enough. He hit the shot when it mattered and it was a great shot he played into the 17th.

**Q. Can you just talk a little bit about the driver changes you were making this week? They mentioned you had gone through three.**

**PAUL BROADHURST:** Yeah, three, which is unusual for me. I've kept the same driver for over two years. I went along to Ping and tried their new driver. Because it was a low spin driver, they decided I needed a more flexible shaft to sort of flight it a little bit better. So I went with that in the pro-am and it wasn't too bad. In the tournament the first day it didn't feel great. It wasn't horrendous, but I missed more fairways than I'm used to. So I decided to put my own shaft in in the new head and went with that one Saturday and that was a bit better. Again, I still wasn't 100 percent sure how it was performing, so yesterday I just went back to what I know, I went back to my old one. It's probably 10 yards shorter, but I know what it's going to do and I hit it pretty straight. Yeah, it was an unusual week in that respect.

**Q. Are you looking forward to the offseason and spending some time at home?**

**PAUL BROADHURST:** Yes and no. We go straight back into lockdown. I know the golf courses are closed until early December as well. Put the clubs away for a month now and look forward to Christmas.

**Q. And then Hawaii?**

We'll probably come over to Orlando and practice the week before, get out of the cold and rain in England, hopefully find a bit of sunshine to warm up for a while.
