JASON KOKRAK (-7)



Q. Jason, how would you describe your round out there?

JASON KOKRAK: Pretty solid. A couple errant swings. Other than that I played very solid. Loose swing with the 3-wood on 11 kind of really didn't set my round out good, but nice birdie on the upcoming par 3 was nice. And I rolled in a couple nice putts, nice two-putt on 1 and then 2, 3 and 4 I made some really nice putts.

Q. Did that little stretch there kind of ignite your round a little bit?

JASON KOKRAK: Yeah, a little bit. It just gives you a little bit of confidence when you see the ball roll in the hole when you've been driving it good all day. Irons have been pretty good. If you see a couple go in, it kind of frees you up to be a little bit more aggressive.

Q. How much did that win at the CJ Cup in the fall kind of give you more confidence when you get in these situations when you're in the mix heading into the weekend?

JASON KOKRAK: It just goes to show that I can do it and the more often you put yourself in that position, the better you're going to feel. So I'm looking forward to this challenge this weekend. Still another 36 holes left, a lot of golf left to be played and you've got to pick and choose where you're going to be aggressive and where you're going to play safe.

Q. Is there one particular thing that you're kind of thinking of that will be kind of your key heading into the weekend?

JASON KOKRAK: Yeah, I've been getting a little too quick with the body. If I can kind of just stay patient, let that golf club drop. We're putting well, hitting the ball pretty solid with the irons, I think that will really help with the driver and the short irons.
