

JEFF MAGGERT (-8)

Q. What's your general approach when you're on the tee at 18?

JEFF MAGGERT: For me, it's just all about the tee shot. You get a good tee shot in play there and you can turn that hole into a birdie hole. You hit a good tee shot, you can get a 6- or 7-iron in your hand there and be aggressive and shoot to the pin. It's an intimidating little tee shot with the big hump in the fairway. If you get it going left, it usually kicks off the hump and gets into the water. So the middle of the fairway's probably 80, 90 yards wide, it's a very tight hole driving.

Q. When you start out the day today, do you look at the leaderboard to sort of figure out in your mind I need to shoot this number to kind of get myself in contention?

JEFF MAGGERT: Not really. I had a terrible start yesterday and then played pretty well after that, so I was just trying to get the momentum that I had yesterday to carry over to today. I just played good, I only made one bogey on 17 and just hit a lot of fairways, lot of iron shots close to the hole.

Q. A lot of the guys that we talked to yesterday, it seemed like they didn't get that much practice time or outside time because of the weather wherever they were living. Did you have a lot of opportunities to play?

JEFF MAGGERT: I was in Texas. It was cold, but it's more about tournament competition and not -- you know, most of the field hasn't played in four months in a tournament, so just getting your competitiveness back and how you handle yourself on the golf course, it takes some time. At least everybody's in the same boat. A few guys had chances to play a few more tournaments. After a day or two you kind of get the feeling back and figure out what you need to be doing right and hopefully you can execute well.

Q. You live in Houston?

JEFF MAGGERT: Houston.

Q. Were you impacted by the outages there?

JEFF MAGGERT: We were pretty chilly there, yeah. We were without power for a day and had a busted water pipe in the house, but got it all fixed up before I got over here. It happens.

Q. So what's your outlook for tomorrow? It looks like a really packed leaderboard,

any number of guys could win this thing.

JEFF MAGGERT: Yeah, looks like the weather forecast could be a bit challenging with some cold weather and wind, but you can't really be looking at that, at the leaderboards. Play golf, hit good golf shots and hopefully you can make a few birdies.
