

**ROUND 3 INTERVIEW**  
**February 27, 2021**



**WEBB SIMPSON (-12)**

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**Q. Webb, you got yourself in contention again. Just recap your day for us today.**

**WEBB SIMPSON:** Yeah, pretty good overall today. You know, a couple loose shots here and there where I scrambled well, but I thought my way around the golf course well. Collin's playing some awesome golf, but still right in it, have a chance to win. I'm a few more back than I wanted to be starting the day, but it's all I can ask, a chance to win on Sunday.

**Q. Was there a shot out there today on a particular hole that really made you happy today?**

**WEBB SIMPSON:** Yeah, I wanted to go for the green on 17, but we were in between clubs and I ended up laying up to the right knowing that that wedge shot's pretty easy, and ended up making birdie. That was a nice disciplined decision and it paid off.

**Q. How will you attack tomorrow given that you're a couple, three back?**

**WEBB SIMPSON:** Yeah, we'll see what the weather does. Again they're calling for wind, but they were today as well and it didn't really blow much. Kind of see where the pins are, kind of see what the wind's doing. And then there's four par 5s out here, so scoring opportunities. Might just be one of those opportunities where you've got to put your foot on the gas a little bit and make some birdies.

**Q. Is this a good chaser's course for Sunday?**

**WEBB SIMPSON:** I think so, because you can go out and be a few under early, but it's not a walk in the park. I think it's a lot like TPC Sawgrass in my opinion where every day you're going to have 65s and 75s. So with four par 5s and a drivable par 4, I think I feel comfortable where I am. I wish I was leading, I wish I was where Collin was, but I feel comfortable knowing I still have a chance.

**Q. Today, was it more difficult today than it has been this week?**

**WEBB SIMPSON:** You know, it was supposed to be windier today, but I think we're so far inland that maybe we don't see the breeze that maybe Sarasota or Bradenton over there by the water. There's some scoring holes still, but pins today were pretty tough. I don't know how many low scores there were, but I still thought it was challenging.

**Q. You told us Thursday you hadn't really put yourself in position to win one of these things, now you have. You have an opportunity tomorrow. Talk about strategy, how**

**you're going to get it done.**

**WEBB SIMPSON:** Yeah, I think I haven't been on like my best form this week, but what I've done I think at a high level is kind of manage my emotions, manage some tough shots here or there where I'm uncomfortable. And I'm putting well. I think tomorrow I've got a chance to win on Sunday, that's all I want, but it's going to be about managing those emotions. There's some uncomfortable shots all throughout the day, but as long as I keep managing well mentally like I've been doing, I think I'll be fine.
