

**ROUND 4 INTERVIEW**

**BROOKS KOEPKA (-15)**

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**Q. Brooks, first off, the neck issue, was it bothering you at all today?**

**BROOKS KOEPKA:** No, today was a good day. No complaints with the neck. Just didn't play good enough.

**Q. Saw you on the range a little earlier than usual. Was that to make sure that nothing tightened up?**

**BROOKS KOEPKA:** Yeah, I was already warm, we worked on it and I just figured I'd come out and keep it warm. Just hit a few balls, just kind of walk around, better than sitting around.

**Q. Overall, what you started in Phoenix is really starting continuing on. What can you say about your success the last few weeks?**

**BROOKS KOEPKA:** Yeah, playing good, I like where my game's at. Putting solid, hitting it good. I've got no complaints, I like where it's at. It's definitely ahead of where it's been in years, years past.

**Q. What did you think of the course this week? Would you like to have the Tour come back for another event here?**

**BROOKS KOEPKA:** Yeah, I'd play it if it came back here. If it goes back to Mexico, you won't see me, though. I struggled with that place.

**Q. You talked about the kind of down times when you were injured, trying to come back, struggling with your game. I know you like winning more than finishing second, but does this give you some assurance that like okay, you won, now you put up another really good finish?**

**BROOKS KOEPKA:** I mean, I lost. I mean, that's not -- it doesn't matter if you finish second or in last, you didn't win. I felt like my game's been really solid, I just didn't see the results early on those first two weeks, but I felt like my game's in good shape. I had a chance to win, just didn't do it. Won in Phoenix. No, I like where my game's at, I just need to keep playing, keep doing the same things I've been doing and hopefully pop off a few more wins.

**Q. So you didn't need a confidence boost this week at all?**

**BROOKS KOEPKA:** No, no, I just wanted to play.

**Q. And then anything in your game that you're going to work on in particular?**

**BROOKS KOEPKA:** No. I mean, just made a few changes with putting, just keep grinding on that next week. Hitting it good, I like where everything is. Just keep doing the same stuff I've been doing. Make sure yardages are correct, ball flight's good and go from there.

**Q. Have you gotten to see Collin Morikawa's game up close much and if so, what do you think of it?**

**BROOKS KOEPKA:** I have not, but I know that when they were thinking of the Presidents Cup when I missed, I wanted him on the team. I remember because the captains will ask us what's going on and I thought he was pretty good from the moment he came out, just seeing scores. I don't think I played with him, but he's pretty solid. That whole young generation, they come out and they're ready to play. And props to him, he's done a good job of it. I wish I would have seen him on that team even though I wasn't there.
