

**PHIL MICKELSON**

**Q.** Phil, thanks for a quick minute. Just to start off, can you tell me about the red you're wearing today?

**PHIL MICKELSON:** So obviously I don't own a red shirt, and so two things happened today. I wore red on Sunday in honor of Tiger, to let him know that all the players really support him and appreciate all that he's done. And I had to buy a red shirt and, of course, every red shirt here has a big "A" on it and I'm not going to flash it but it's under here. It's two things that I have never done I did today, and I hope he knows that we're supporting him.

**Q. Absolutely.**

**PHIL MICKELSON:** Because that was a lot for me to do that. Just kidding.

**Q. Talk about your round today. Obviously it wasn't the outcome that you wanted. Can you just talk us through what that looked like?**

**PHIL MICKELSON:** Yes. I don't I'm frustrated obviously. I'm not playing I haven't played well for a little while, and yet the parts seem like they're there when I'm home. I have great practice sessions, but I'm not putting it together on the course and it's been frustrating. Yet I still loved and enjoyed playing here, being a part of this event and reminiscing on a lot of great things that have happened in my life and my career right here in this spot. So it's been a fun week even though I haven't played as well as I would have liked.

**Q. Played 15 today. What clubs did you use, what was your decision making there?**

**ANNA NORD:** So with the strong wind I couldn't get there if I hit iron. I couldn't carry the water with driver. And I'm out of the tournament essentially. So I just hit a 2wood up 10 fairway and I only had about 215 to the hole and took a 4wood over the trees, just high and let the wind hit it just on the front edge there, just short of the green, and this is the kind of stuff that I've been doing. I hit a decent chip, but I left it above the hole, missed the putt and made a five. I hit a lot of decent shots and made a five and I've got to fix that somehow.

**Q. What happened on 9?**

**PHIL MICKELSON:** So 9, again, I actually hit the shot I wanted. I misjudged the wind.

When I got to the tee box the wind was right to left and quartering down. I was worried about the outofbounds left, and as I was about to hit it started to quarter back in and I thought it's not going to be in. It's been down the whole time. And so I went ahead and hit just a nice high cut driver, and I actually hit it right on my line and the wind hammered it and it didn't cover the water, which I didn't think was even going to be an issue, especially if we had helping wind it would have covered it by 30, 40 yards. So I don't know what to say. It just one of those things. Then I compounded it by messing up around the greens, blah, blah, blah, whatever.
