



ADAM SCHENK ( -6)

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**Q. So, Adam, bogey-free 65 out there. What did you like about your round?**

**ADAM SCHENK:** You know, my putter's continuing to be hot for me, which is a lot of times the difference out here. I'm hitting it just fine, finding some fairways. The rough's pretty long so you need to avoid that out here, but really just made some putts today, honestly.

**Q. How much momentum have you been on these last couple of weeks? I think this is your 10th straight round under par and you were really in the mix at John Deere a couple weeks ago.**

**ADAM SCHENK:** Yeah, I didn't know it was 10. I know it's been several. I've had some good weeks on some courses that I'm comfortable on, so to continue that today, it was nice. I felt like I was going to play well going into today, but that doesn't always happen. It's nice when it does, but doing everything fairly similar, just having a little bit hotter of a putter, and if it stays hot the rest of the week, that would be great and just ride it as long as possible. It never stays forever, but it's nice when it does happen.

**Q. You got to play with Lucas at the final round at John Deere you and you went toe to toe with him for pretty much the entire round. What kind of things did you learn about being in a pressure situation by playing with him that Sunday?**

**ADAM SCHENK:** Yeah, he played really nice, and he's one of my favorite guys to play with out here. He's so nice, very comfortable pairing to play with. I played with him several times. Just a good person, easy to root for, so it was a comfortable pairing, which was helpful for me that day. We both played nice. I made a bogey on hole 15 out there and he birdied it and kind of pulled away from there and he had a great up-and-down the last hole and I left my birdie putt short, but I was right there. I couldn't have asked for a much better week, so I was just fortunate.

**Q. And what did you learn from being in that position?**

**ADAM SCHENK:** What did I learn. I guess I learned that maybe I'm good enough to win out here if I'm that close. If I could have just finished off a little better, I was right there, so that's probably something valuable to take away.

**Q. Coming off a good week a couple weeks ago at the John Deere, got some momentum. Looks like you got your old coach, Rob Bradley, on the bag. How has he helped you in this stretch? I know he's not your full-time caddie, but how has he helped?**

**ADAM SCHENK:** Yeah, he's definitely very helpful. He's not scared to tell me what I need to be told, which doesn't always happen with a lot of players out here. I feel like you're always told what you need to be told and hey, stop having a bad attitude, you just hit a wedge to 30 feet, just go two-putt. So he's not scared to tell me what I need to hear sometimes. He knows me pretty well, obviously very well, as good as anybody, and it's just fun having him on the bag.

**Q. Obviously the rain delay, you came back, you had six holes left to play and you finished up nicely on that back nine. Obviously it helps some players, other players it doesn't help. How did you spend that time, and were you able to refocus?**

**ADAM SCHENK:** Yeah, I feel like I've always done well after restarts. I don't know if there's any rhyme or reason to it, but maybe it's in my head now, so anytime there's a restart, I feel like it's an advantage for me. Same thing kind of happened at Barbasol last week, there was a couple delays, did all right after them. So if I think it's an advantage, I guess it is. Who knows if it is actually, but it's good.

**Q. Obviously the regular season is winding down, you're 109th in FedExCup points. Would it be fair to say that 109th is like driving in heavy traffic and you're kind of looking over your shoulder seeing if anybody's going to pass you? Is it an uncomfortable feeling?**

**ADAM SCHENK:** Yes. I don't know what the safe number is, but it's close, but it would be nice to have a good week here and not have to worry about it and start inching toward the Top-70 and get in the BMW and have a good week and hopefully get in the Top-30.
