CHEZ REAVIE (-9)

Q. Chez, off to a great start through two rounds. Just kind of assess the first couple days for yourself.

CHEZ REAVIE: Yeah, kind of played solid, gave myself a lot of looks, rolled in a few putts. Yeah, we just really played solid.

Q. You had a stretch this season where you missed 10 cuts in 12 starts. One, how challenging was that to hang in there?

CHEZ REAVIE: It was just more annoying than anything else. Wasn't playing bad, missed a lot of cuts by a shot and golf seemed really tough at the time. You know, I just kind of fought through it and here we are playing well. I've played well the last few weeks and that's what I'm going to focus on.

Q. What were the biggest factors in kind of getting past that?

CHEZ REAVIE: Just playing. You've just got to play your way through it. It's one thing if you're really playing poorly, but I really wasn't. It was just I went brain dead for a few holes on Thursday or Friday and I'd shoot 74 or 75 or make a triple or just do something out of the ordinary for me. So it was just really kind of honing in on my focus.

Q. What is it like knowing that you have to shoot a 66 or 67 to stay with the leaders?

CHEZ REAVIE: Well, I mean, that's what it is every week out here, right? That's why we're the best in the world. It's really nothing new this week. And in order to win golf tournaments out here, you've got to go to beat the best in the world, so I wouldn't expect anything else.

Q. What are you most encouraged by this week as far as your game goes?

CHEZ REAVIE: Mainly the putter. I've really hit a lot of good putts. Even like on the last hole, didn't go in but I hit a great putt and it had every opportunity to go in, so that's just what I want to focus on for the weekend.
