

**JHONATTAN VEGAS (-9)**

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**Q. Could you just recap how you played out there today?**

**JHONATTAN VEGAS:** Played solid overall. Nothing great. I just feel like it was just manage my game fairly well until the last hole pretty much. Made a couple of bogeys on 13 and 14 hitting pretty good shots that ended up in really awkward places. Feel like I played solid. I feel I like I'm keeping the ball in play pretty well, giving myself enough chances, making a few putts, which is always good. The wind is blowing and it's kind of that intensity that is a little bit annoying, especially some of those shots with so much water around this place. But played solid. I can't really complain too much.

**Q. What happened on your last hole? What iron did you hit?**

**JHONATTAN VEGAS:** You know what, just 193, went in from the right, just kind of got in between trying to hit a cut or hit it straight. Should have hit a cut to hold it into the wind and decided to hit it straight and kind of came across and hit it long left and I was completely dead from there. I was trying to make a 5, obviously it's a short one that I feel like I should have made. It's golf, sometimes you've got to put those behind and focus on what's coming.

**Q. What iron was it?**

**JHONATTAN VEGAS:** It was a 6-iron, a 6-iron from 193. Like I said, not an easy pin position with this wind.

**Q. Can you talk about the unique challenge of going to the first tee knowing you have to put up a really low number to keep pace in a tournament like this?**

**JHONATTAN VEGAS:** It's hard, it's really hard, but at the end of the day, and especially coming off a good round, you've just got to try to piece another good round together. You can't really get too impatient around any golf course because you're going to pay for it. You've got to take advantage of the holes that you've got to take advantage of and try to piece together a good round, which I felt like I was doing pretty well until that last hole today. Obviously the conditions are not super easy, you still have to hit really good shots around this place. Obviously if you hit it well and you make a few putts, you can shoot really low.

**Q. Same score as yesterday, but did you make No. 18 a little less of an adventure today than you did last night?**

**JHONATTAN VEGAS:** Yes, pretty much had the same number and hit two clubs less today, so I think I learned my lesson there.

**Q. Did they ever find the ball?**

**JHONATTAN VEGAS:** Yeah, they found it yesterday, last night. They did, yeah.

**Q. Inside the tent?**

**JHONATTAN VEGAS:** Inside the tent, yeah.

**Q. How much of a factor is that, such a late night and early start today?**

**JHONATTAN VEGAS:** It's part of what we have to deal with here on Tour, some late and early. Obviously we finished super late yesterday. By the time I got to bed it was almost 11:00 p.m., got up really early. It's just part of what we do and part of being a professional athlete.

**Q. What did you hit yesterday and what did you hit today?**

**JHONATTAN VEGAS:** I hit 3-iron and hit easy 5-iron today. The darkness really played a big factor on that club yesterday.

**Q. You said last night you played it because you guys were in a hurry to beat the light?**

**JHONATTAN VEGAS:** We were in a hurry. We literally got the wrong number to that back pin and just literally -- I pretty much hit it today where the pin was yesterday with an easy 5-iron and I hit a 3-iron yesterday. Just completely messed up. Luckily, like I said, we found the ball, I made 4 yesterday, but hopefully we can make the hole a little bit easier next time.
