

KEVIN STREELMAN (-8)

Q. Kevin, I was half joking with you about a Duke guy and you're right there. What's it going to take this weekend, do you think?

KEVIN STREELMAN: I mean, clearly the greens are just perfect this week, so if you're hitting fairways, you can attack. They're receptive enough to proper golf shots. Like I said, the greens are running so well that you can make a lot of putts. I've just got to keep hitting fairways and controlling iron shots into greens and keep the putter hot and I should have a good chance.

Q. Is that what's been good, being in the fairway? You've got to be in the fairway to score on this course, don't you?

KEVIN STREELMAN: Yeah, you absolutely do. It's one of the most important of the year to be in the fairway. The rough is a dense, thick Bermuda. You get the hot flyers. You can get the fluffy chunkers sometimes, too. It's just very unpredictable and difficult to predict how it's going to come out of the rough, but from the fairway you can attack.

Q. And how well do you know Alex?

KEVIN STREELMAN: I do know Alex. I think at the Phoenix Open they gave him a spot and I went up to him and introduced myself. I think he's 20 years younger than I am, so in a way I'm proud that I'm still out here at that age and young guys are coming up, but at the same time you almost feel like the father figure, almost. You're past the big brother stage.

Q. Joe Ogilvie was there for you.

KEVIN STREELMAN: He was. Joe was five years ahead of me, Ryan Blaum was five years behind me and then Adam Long was five years behind him. So it's kind of been on that five-year cycle with Dukies. But Alex is a great kid. He's obviously got a huge future in front of him and hopefully we can play together tomorrow, it'd would be a lot of fun.

Q. And he's a member here, so that kind of helps a little bit, I think, doesn't it?

KEVIN STREELMAN: That always helps. I didn't know that, but that does help.

Q. One more thing, Kevin. What do you think on the weekend, you mentioned what it's going to take, but do you have a score in mind now that you're 8 under? Maybe another 8 under?

KEVIN STREELMAN: Yeah, exactly. You've got to get to the mid to high teens, I'm sure. The wind I don't think's going to be a huge factor. Hopefully the thunderstorms stay away, but these greens stay the way they are, you're going to make some putts.
