

MATTHEW WOLFF (-1, MC)

Q. Matthew, I know not the result you wanted for the week, but I did want to congratulate you on winning the Aon Risk-Reward Challenge today, \$1 million. If you can just comment a little bit about what that means to you.

MATTHEW WOLFF: Yeah, it means a lot. I think, you know, obviously there's a lot of money to be made out on Tour, but I'm new out here and every little bit helps. And Aon puts on a great contest, year-long contest. Just happy that I got it done. And I knew about it kind of the last couple months, so on the Aon know holes I was a little more nervous than I usually am, but played them pretty well and just came out on top.

Q. Yeah, the challenge is about making the best decision on some of the most challenging holes. What does that say a little bit about your execution and planning for those holes?

MATTHEW WOLFF: Yeah, I think just usually like it's the Aon Risk-Reward Challenge and I'm a pretty risky player and I guess it just happened to turn out in my favor on those holes. I feel like I have a pretty good game plan every single week, but seems like those holes I just have a better one.

Q. Speaking of that game plan, just talk a little bit about the interaction that you and your caddie have figuring out a game plan and a strategy on tough holes as well.

MATTHEW WOLFF: Yeah, I mean, you nailed it, they're tough holes. I think the most important thing is to just stick to what we discussed and still be aggressive and take aggressive swings on conservative lines. I feel like that's kind of a game plan that I've stuck to and, like I said, it's worked out on those few holes.

Q. Who told you that you were leading?

MATTHEW WOLFF: I've known for a while. I was going to say my agent kind of brought it to me firsthand, but it's a million dollars, so kind of grabs your attention.

Q. How happy were you when you heard that Louis had pulled out? I think he was the one guy that could catch you.

MATTHEW WOLFF: I mean, I'm not happy when anyone pulls out. If I'm going to win the Challenge, I want to win it because I play the best golf, not because someone gives it to me. I feel like I did that and on those holes I happened to play them really well. I think I was averaging like a stroke under par every single week or according to the contest, so I played those holes correctly, just got to play the rest of the holes right.
