

**ROGER SLOAN (-11)**

**Q. Roger, great playing, 64 today following a 64 yesterday. What's been working so well for you the last two rounds?**

**ROGER SLOAN:** I think in the first round I dusted off a few of those jitters and then I was just able to settle in the last few holes on Thursday. Yeah, I really like this golf course, I like a lot of the sightlines off the tee. These greens are so good, you just put the ball online and it's going to go in the hole. It's a great track.

**Q. And how important was this round for you knowing you're coming in just outside that Top-125 and how big a round it tomorrow going to be?**

**ROGER SLOAN:** I mean, I'll let you guys kind of figure that out. As far as I'm concerned, there's a trophy to be won and everything will kind of take care of itself.

**Q. When it's really, really hot like this, do you do anything differently when you're out on a day like this when you know it's going to be a little bit brutal?**

**ROGER SLOAN:** Yeah, sometimes I'll hydrate a little bit differently. BioSteel, it's a supplement that you just put in your drink, helps replacing my electrolytes. For me it's really away from the course, so when I go home tonight, drinking a lot of water, really hydrating myself, recovering so that I have enough energy for tomorrow.

**Q. Did you do that for today?**

**ROGER SLOAN:** Yeah.

**Q. Thinking back on your career, is there any round or anyplace you can say this was the hottest conditions I've ever played in?**

**ROGER SLOAN:** We've played in some really hot places. I think when the Barbasol used to be played in Alabama, that was like playing on the surface of the sun. This is always a hot week just with the humidity. Yeah, it's just it comes and goes with the heat waves.

**Q. Last one, obviously you did well today. Do you consider yourself a good heat player?**

**ROGER SLOAN:** I'd like to think so. I grew up in the dry heat of British Columbia. I live in Houston now, this is really like my backyard playing in this type of condition, so I think I've climatized well to this.
