

ROUND 4 INTERVIEW

MATT KUCHAR (- 10)

Q. Overall comments about characterizing this week and takeaways for momentum going forward?

MATT KUCHAR: I really enjoy the golf course. My first time here at Sedgefield and certainly hope to be back. It's a fun place to play golf, so many unique, fun holes. I had always heard good things from other players, but getting out here, you've got to do everything well. It requires every club in the bag and it's a good test of golf.

Q. Kind of a strange week where you don't know exactly where you stand on the course probably. Now you know, you're 119. You never like to say definite, but it looks good. At the end of that round, did you have a sense of what you needed to do?

MATT KUCHAR: I don't know that you ever -- there's just too much math to try to compute to figure out the guys behind you, the guys in front of you. I don't think it's ever a done deal unless you're the last guy on the course, then maybe you know. Other than that, it's tricky trying to figure out points and how guys both in front of you and behind you are doing.

Q. How do you feel now that you -- are you going to watch? Like what do you do now that you're kind of on the bubble, kind of not?

MATT KUCHAR: I think I've played well enough to not have to watch. Always interesting, this tournament always provides some interesting drama coming down to the end to see who's inside the Top-125 and who's outside. I'll probably pay attention because there's always some sort of good story.

Q. What was the club and yardage on 18 there?

MATT KUCHAR: I think we had 180 yards, 7-iron. Turned out great. I figured a normal 7-iron was going to come up close to pin high, maybe a little short. I hit it as flush as I could hit it and it went past the hole and thankfully there was a backstop there I used and trickled back to three feet from the hole.

Q. And then going into the Playoffs, I mean, you've had some success, maybe not -- you've won the Northern Trust but not at the same course.

MATT KUCHAR: Yeah, yeah.

Q. Do you have just good mojo going into that event?

MATT KUCHAR: I'm pleased with the state of my game. I missed the cut last week, but I knew I was doing some really good things. Nice to have a solid week here. I feel good, I feel pleased with how I'm hitting it, how I'm putting it. I feel good about the state of my game.

Shoot, listen, I know I've got to have a great week to continue moving on, but I think the unique thing about the Playoffs, you multiply the points time four and if you start doing some good things, you can find yourself moving up and turning a good week into a great week with all the points and the ability to really move up on the list.

Q. Did you feel like you needed one more birdie at the last hole --

MATT KUCHAR: No.

Q. -- to feel comfortable?

MATT KUCHAR: No. I don't know, I don't know if it even moved me. Did it move me on the list, the birdie?

Q. I'm not sure. Did Tom Walter tell you you're in?

MATT KUCHAR: He said I'm 119, he said you're in, yeah, yeah. He said it may go to 120 or 121 even, but it's not going outside 125. It's a funny place to be, I've never had to really sweat that, or it's been a long time since I've -- it feels like trying to make a cut.
