

**ROUND 4 INTERVIEW**  
**October 17, 2021**



**TALOR GOOCH (-21)**

**Q. Talor, that was a fantastic round. That must have felt good.**

**TAYLOR GOOCH:** Oh, yeah, anytime you shoot 10 under on the PGA TOUR or anywhere it's a good round, so that was fun, and capped it off with a pretty sweet last shot.

**Q. Was that all about a hot putter or was this just everything coming together?**

**TAYLOR GOOCH:** I really, I think I only made about one putt outside of six or eight feet. I made about a 25-footer, 20-footer on 16, but I was hitting it close all day. It was as easy of a 62 as you could imagine.

**Q. Looking at your last two events, you've had a nice strong start to the new season. Is it a continuation of what you've been doing well the last few weeks?**

**TAYLOR GOOCH:** You know, for the last six months I've actually been playing some really good golf, the results just haven't come. So my team, we've talked about it, just got to stay patient, wait for your time and we know you're doing all the right things. We knew good golf was coming, so it's nice for it to finally show up.

**Q. It's quite difficult being a golfer to try to be patient, isn't it?**

**TAYLOR GOOCH:** Oh, yeah, no doubt about it. You bust your butt every day and you try to make the results happen and they don't always happen when you think they should or when you want them to, but you just have to have faith, have patience and know that your time's coming.

**Q. Talk us through that eagle on 18. You were 19 under at the time, leaders are 21 under. What was going through your mind?**

**TAYLOR GOOCH:** Yeah, that tee shot, I haven't liked it. Made a couple bogeys the first and second day. I hit in the bunker and was a little frustrated and couldn't get it on the green. So I was like, man, we've just got to lay up to a wedge, and it was a good wedge number and like I said, I was hitting it close all day. I've hit three or four other wedges inside of, you know, five feet. So that was -- it was a perfect number, perfect shot and it's nice when it comes together like that.

**Q. When you get a hot round like this, is this something like you get a few birdies in a row and then you feel like, hey, this could be my day, or do you just let it roll and see what comes your way?**

**TAYLOR GOOCH:** Man, for me, I just let it roll. I think I was 5 under through six and so at that point you're like, all right, we can do something good. And then I made four or five pars in a row and then you're like, all right, we've got to get this rolling again. It's just, this course, you never know when your time's going to come. There's a bunch of birdies, but you just keep trying to hit good shots and try to make it happen. You know you've got to make a bunch of birdies to keep up, but fortunately I was able to make a few early and then cap it off with a few late.

**Q. And I believe I'm correct in this, but you played in the Shriners last week; just confirming that.**

**TAYLOR GOOCH:** Um-hmm.

**Q. What's the first thing that comes to your mind about spending two weeks in Las Vegas playing golf?**

**TAYLOR GOOCH:** It's a tax-free state, I like that part. I like it here. The weather's good. It's a little bit different at elevation here from back home to here. The ball goes a little bit different, so you have to make some adjustments here. But man, last week and this week, putting on bent greens feels like home for me so it's nice. We don't often get to putt on bent greens, so that's a big plus coming out here.

**Q. And what did you think of The Summit, seeing it for the first time?**

**TAYLOR GOOCH:** Oh, it's incredible, it's incredible. I would love to have a place here someday. This place is awesome. The golf course is great. I know the scores are low, but that doesn't take anything away from how great the place is. I know next year we're going to be going overseas back to Korea, but I wouldn't mind if we stayed here, too.

**Q. And obviously Las Vegas is a little bit different atmosphere than any other place on Tour off the course. What's the first thing that comes to your mind over the last two weeks?**

**TAYLOR GOOCH:** Great food. I love it here. I'm actually not a huge gambler, so that's not what I -- I just love the food. I have friends that come out, come hang out. It's a fun couple weeks and it's nice when I get off the course. You know, you go back and hang out and do something other than think about golf, which is good.

**Q. Looking at where you are on the leaderboard now, what would you do, just hang out, have some food, watch some TV?**

**TAYLOR GOOCH:** Yeah, I don't think that that's going to hold up very long. So I have a flight at 7:00 and so I'll hang out until it's for sure not going to do it, but I don't think that's going to last too long out here.
