BERNHARD LANGER (-11)

ALLIE LeCLAIR: With Bernhard Langer. Can you take us through your round a little bit today? You had six birdies, five on the front nine.

BERNHARD LANGER: Five, I think. Five and one bogey, so it's a good start. Got off to a great start, hit the ball pretty decent and made some putts. Then I played very solid, but the pins are tough and the greens are very firm, so it's difficult to get the ball near the hole to stop when the pins are in the front, and when the pins are in the back, you don't go over the back, so it's a tricky situation.

Then not pleased with my par-par-par finish, two par 5s. Wish I had made one birdie at least, but just lack of length off the tee put me in a position where it wasn't easy, but still could have made one birdie somewhere and I didn't. Got to just make it up tomorrow.

Q. On this golf course at this place, must feel like an old comfortable shoe for you.

BERNHARD LANGER: Yeah, been here every tournament like most of the guys in the field have been here a lot. It's a great golf course, very demanding. This year the greens are firmer than ever, I think, and the ball just doesn't stop as quick, but it's in phenomenal shape and the weather is fantastic.

Q. Any magic considering all the people that are going to be shooting for the top tomorrow?

BERNHARD LANGER: Magic? What do you mean?

Q. Is something there? Is another 63 --

BERNHARD LANGER: Don't know. I'm going to go as low as I can because I'm going to have to. There's a lot of guys right there and thereabouts and that's all we can do.
