Q. What do you kind of like focus on over the weekend? Is there anything you kind of work toward, anything you're kind of working on for the Tour in 2022?

DAVIS LOVE III: Yeah, I'm coming back from another hip replacement, so I'm trying to get my balance and my speed and my timing down. I just get quick from the top. It's not any secret, I just get a little anxious and I get a little quick. And I'm trying to hit it out there with these long-hitting kids or if I'm on the Champions Tour with Fred Couples. So I've just got to get my balance and my timing down. So that will be nice to play a couple more rounds here, then it's off to Hawaii.

Q. You just mentioned the hip replacement. How are you feeling?

DAVIS LOVE III: I'm feeling really good. Now I have a little problem with my thumb now that I've had my hip fixed, but when you're 57 and played a million rounds of golf, it adds up. I'm 90 percent, which is the best I've been in a long time.
