



**CAMERON YOUNG (-17)**

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**Q. Obviously a huge week for you, World Ranking points and FedExCup points. Are you happy with that right now or does it still sting with the loss?**

**CAMERON YOUNG:** Yeah, I mean, I think kind of once the iron shot on 18 doesn't go in, you're kind of like accepting what's going on. I mean, Joaquin wasn't going to three-putt that realistically, he's been so good all week. Overall you finish tied for second at Riviera, I can't complain. I mean, I'm lucky just to be here and I know it does some good things for me going forward, so I am happy with the week, for sure.

**Q. Kind of a unique experience, the two of you were out in front basically from Friday not even afternoon, all the way through. What was that like? Have you ever had that experience before?**

**CAMERON YOUNG:** I don't think I really have. It was certainly fun to watch him play, especially early yesterday, he was making everything, hitting some great shots. Yeah, it was fun. I felt like I played really well given -- it's kind of hard to keep running away. You always assume someone like Collin's going to shoot 65 like he did today. I know there's a million guys right there that were within striking distance of shooting 64 or 65. Yeah, I'm proud of myself for staying up there for a long time. There was a couple shots I wish I had back today, but all in all happy with the week.

**Q. You holed out there on 15. Did you think that maybe something --**

**CAMERON YOUNG:** You never know, and then I shanked one in the bunker. Yeah, I mean, that was just a big one. We've been saying something's going in and that's not the one I thought was going in. We were talking about a 10-footer at some point today would have been nice, but it kept me in it, for sure. You're staring bogey in the face and to go to the next hole only two back, that's a chance with three to play.

**Q. The last time you had your future secured early you said you didn't quite handle it the way you wanted to and went off the gas. How do you make sure the rest of the season you keep that foot down?**

**CAMERON YOUNG:** Yeah, I mean, I think it's kind of just -- I think it's in a lot of our blood to keep the pedal down a little bit. Came out today taking a couple conservative lines early not because I was trying to hang onto second, but just because I knew the longer I hung around, you just never know what happens. Yeah, I think it's just something that a lot of us will do. I don't think anyone would say no, I'm just trying to finish second. I was out there trying to win.

**Q. Are you confident? Obviously you're going to Florida next week and it's a place I'm told you won played a pretty big junior event, you've got some familiarity there. Excited to try to keep the momentum going?**

**CAMERON YOUNG:** Yeah, for sure. I haven't played there in a long time, but I know I liked it when I did play it. I think I'm just hitting the ball really well and I putted really well with the exception of today, all week, so I think my game's in a good place and I'm looking forward to getting home.

**Q. When you started the season as a rookie before you even played on the Tour, if we had told you you would be in this position on the FedExCup list at this point, would you have expected it, not expected it, happy with it?**

**CAMERON YOUNG:** I certainly would have believed you. I would have been thrilled with it, I'm sure. Still a little -- not upset I didn't win today, but I mean, I wanted to win very badly. I mean, I happily would have taken it if you had handed it to me. Yeah, we just keep going, we go to the next week and see what happens.

**Q. You played 36 this weekend with Joaquin. What part of his game really impressed you?**

**CAMERON YOUNG:** He putted beautifully, he drove it fantastic. With the exception of a couple yesterday, he really drove it great. He hit just a flat draw off almost every hole. Then his speed on the greens is so good. I don't think anyone did better with that this week than he did.

**Q. What was your yardage and club on 8, second shot?**

**CAMERON YOUNG:** I just bladed a lob wedge. It was 108 and just off the upslope. I was trying not to catch one too spinny and it took a big bounce, see ya.

**Q. Having that happen, did that affect at all your second shot to 10?**

**CAMERON YOUNG:** No. The second shot to 10 I hit really how I meant to. In the air it looked like it was perfect. My caddie said in the air it looked like it was perfect. I hit it just how I meant to, about a foot right of the hole because that's the only place that it could have stopped. I struck it great, but it just carried a foot too short.
