Q. You rolled in a couple long putts.

Q. Did the putter feel good today?

MIGUEL ANGEL JIMENEZ: Putter feel good today, much better than yesterday, yeah. The game is very solid but the putting today, but as I say, I holed a couple of putts.

Q. How do you feel about your position heading into tomorrow?

MIGUEL ANGEL JIMENEZ: How are you thinking? You are first, feel good, no?

Q. I would think so. What happened on 17?

MIGUEL ANGEL JIMENEZ: Seventeenth, I missed my 3-wood and I put the ball in the water and then I had to drop there and I hit a beautiful third shot with my 3-wood over the trees, nearly just fall into the bunker and then I make a nice -- I made a par there. It's very good, very solid. Very solid par still, you know.

Q. Once you were in that position on 18, was bogey kind of what you were thinking or did you think maybe par was still in play?

MIGUEL ANGEL JIMENEZ: I tried to make a par, of course. I hit a shot on the green and I hit a very good putt and it nearly went in. That's the game.
