

MIGUEL ANGEL JIMENEZ (-18)

Q. Miguel, can you just start with how special it feels to win this event?

MIGUEL ANGEL JIMENEZ: Always to win a tournament always have very special moment. Shows how's your game and everything. I've been there several times here, been close the last couple of years I have played this tournament and at the end of this year I get it. My game was very good, solid.

Q. Can you speak to winning two of the first three tournaments of this season?

MIGUEL ANGEL JIMENEZ: 60 percent positivity, that's very nice. It's nice. I've been playing good, been hitting very solid and working hard.

Q. Walk us through the hole-in-one. What were you thinking, what were you looking at?

MIGUEL ANGEL JIMENEZ: Well, the flag is on the left side of the green on the back left and my number is perfect for me. Go a little bit into the breeze, I hit a beautiful 6-iron for 178 yards and ace.

Q. Did you ever imagine having two aces in one tournament?

MIGUEL ANGEL JIMENEZ: No. I have 13 aces in tournaments already, but first time I have two in the same tournament. You never think about it. You want to hit a good shot and hit it as close as possible.

Q. What does it mean for you to win here in Tucson?

MIGUEL ANGEL JIMENEZ: To me to win any tournament is amazing. To win in Tucson is nice because, as I said before, shows you are in good form and looking forward. It's very important for me to win any tournament. In this case we are playing Tucson here, it's a great place.

Q. So you make that hole-in-one and you're up by five at that point. Do you have to kind of guard against thinking that it's over? Still have to focus?

MIGUEL ANGEL JIMENEZ: You know, you never know. You have a few more holes with some water, you need to be focused on your shots. You have a five-shot lead but you have to keep concentrating and focus. As the professional you have to do that way.

Q. Do you have to control your emotions, too?

MIGUEL ANGEL JIMENEZ: Of course, of course you control your emotions.

Q. Did you work on some things in the offseason? You've got to two wins in three tries. Is there something different about your game?

MIGUEL ANGEL JIMENEZ: No, no, the same thing. This weekend I've been -- game on the greens is a little better and there you are. Been playing very solid and now this season the putting is good.

Q. The other hole-in-one was all a 6-iron?

MIGUEL ANGEL JIMENEZ: Yeah.

Q. Was Jerry Kelly your good luck charm do you think?

MIGUEL ANGEL JIMENEZ: Well, too, both days I played with him when I made the hole-in-one, yeah.

Q. How would you -- what would you say is the biggest factor in your game being in such good form right now?

MIGUEL ANGEL JIMENEZ: My irons. I'm hitting from tee to green probably is the key of my game at this moment. The putter started working. The key of my game is tee to green.

Q. Most champions, the helmet, they put it on for a minute and then they put it down. You seemed to enjoy wearing it.

MIGUEL ANGEL JIMENEZ: I'm trying to (inaudible).

Q. Did it feel pretty good on your head?

MIGUEL ANGEL JIMENEZ: Feel very nice, of course. You see? Nice.

Q. You're chasing Bernhard's 43 wins.
