

**BERNHARD LANGER ( -14)**

**Q. So, overall, how do you assess the weekend?**

**BERNHARD LANGER:** It was great. Played pretty good, 65 today on Sunday, 7 under is always special. Almost shot my age. Just Jimenez was too good this week. He's had a nice lead going into today and he's on fire again. He's a great player and we were basically battling it out for second between Woody Austin and myself.

**Q. What's the evolution of your relationship with Miguel, like how would you describe your connection with him?**

**BERNHARD LANGER:** There's no evolution. We played golf together for many, many years. Played on the Ryder Cup together. He played when I was captain, he was a player, 2004 at Oakland Hills. He's from Spain, I'm from Germany. We've been playing the same tournaments, I don't know, 40 years now, something like that or more. Yeah, he's a unique character and we've had some good times together.

**Q. So he's probably going to win today obviously. You won it a few years ago. What does it take to win this event?**

**BERNHARD LANGER:** Shoot lower than anybody else, it's very simple. You've got to play a lot of good shots. It's a ball-striker's golf course, you've got to control your tee shots and then also hit really good irons to give yourself opportunities to make some putts.

**Q. What do you remember about what you won it here?**

**BERNHARD LANGER:** I had a very good finish. It was close with about nine holes to go, or six, then I pulled away. I was happy to, you know, finish very good on the back nine and separate myself. My goal was always to be in contention coming in for the last nine holes and then see whoever plays the best nine will win and I was able to do that.

**Q. Have you had two aces in a tournament before?**

**BERNHARD LANGER:** No.

**Q. So for Miguel to do that, how rare is that?**

**BERNHARD LANGER:** Did he have another ace? I don't know, I played golf, so yeah, that's unheard of.

**Q. What's next for you?**

**BERNHARD LANGER:** No wonder he's 18 under. We're all going to Newport next week for the Hoag Classic.
