**Q. Just a couple comments on that ace. What number was it in your career?**

**SCOTT GUTSCHEWSKI:** I think it was my fifth. First one in a while. Like, all of them but one have been in tournaments. I think I had my first one on my 15-year-old's first birthday in a pro-am in Louisiana. Second one I think was in Colombia in a Korn Ferry event. I had one at Turning Stone, we used to play out there. Then had one back at home, so I think that's five.

**Q. The second in tournament play?**

**SCOTT GUTSCHEWSKI:** The second -- well, yeah, like legit tournament play. Third in tournament play. Korn Ferry event in Colombia, Turning Stone back when I forget what it used to be called and then here. But I think three or four of them have been with 7-irons, which is kind of weird.

**Q. Yeah, that is. So how was it, just overall recap of -- did they give you some energy moving forward?**

**SCOTT GUTSCHEWSKI:** Yeah, I mean, I kind of -- I made birdie on 18 and 1 to get to 2 under, then kind of made a sloppy bogey on 2 and then just parred 3. Hit a really good shot on 4, but didn't make the putt. It was kind of strong with the putter and just, I mean it was a really good number, a little bit helping wind and hit it and it looked really good in the air and I was like wow, I hit that. It was a good one. I didn't like chunk it or blade it. Yeah, it looked good the whole way. I was looking at it like wow, that looks really good.
