**Q. What would you assess as the key to your great playing today?**

**TONY FINAU:** I'm really happy with my round today, that's what I'll say. I haven't had a great season and just sometimes it's just how it goes. It's the game that we play. I really wanted to put together a nice week and I was able to do that this week and gave myself a chance to do something special right at the end. Making a 3 on 18 probably would have been a big deal, but making that putt for birdie, a lot of confidence builders on a day like today and I'll carry that with me the rest of the season no matter what happens today.
