**KURT KITAYAMA (-16)**

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**Q. Kurt, so kind of what are your emotions overall about the week? Tied for second, your best finish on the PGA TOUR.**

**KURT KITAYAMA:** I feel like I can compete up there when there's a lot of pressure on the line. I feel like I can handle my emotions fairly well to, you know, keep it under control.

**Q. Is it for kind of -- you mentioned ecstatic. Is there a little bit kind of replaying shots here and there with being one short of a playoff?**

**KURT KITAYAMA:** No. You'll just, you know, be thinking about it all night if you do that. I just let it go and happy where I finished.

**Q. What was it like playing with Jon Rahm? What impresses you about just him, his game in general?**

**KURT KITAYAMA:** He's just a really good player. He got off to a slow start and just kind of slowly prodded along and didn't really waiver much. He's just overall a solid player.
