

BRANDON WU (-16)

Q. A great round 63 and giving yourself a chance and see how it unfolds, but how would you assess the day and what was clicking and the whole week?

BRANDON WU: Yeah, I played awesome today. Tried to keep it easy, that was kind of the game plan with me and my caddie. Hit a lot of greens, hit a lot of fairways. The conditions were kind of tough especially towards the middle and the end of the round, there's some tough holes with the wind, but yeah, I just tried to play my game and it was good.

Q. On 18 coming down, were you looking at the leaderboard or seeing what might be the number for a playoff?

BRANDON WU: No, I tried to not look. I feel like I just try my best and if it works, it works, and if I'm one or two short, whatever. I figured I would be close. I figured a birdie would help my chances, but I still played great today and that was awesome.

Q. You have three top-10s now on the PGA Tour outside of the U.S. Is that coincidence or is there anything --

BRANDON WU: I don't know, I just try to play my best wherever I am and hopefully keep going.

Q. The Spanish-speaking countries, do you speak Spanish at all?

BRANDON WU: I don't speak Spanish, but the Tour makes quite a few stops in some Spanish-speaking countries, which is awesome, and you get to experience the culture a little bit. Yeah, it's been really fun down here this week.

Q. You had missed a few cuts in a row but then you found something with the third and you kind of strung some solid results together. Is there anything that clicked in your game at that time that led to these results being better?

BRANDON WU: I think the ball-striking is the biggest kind of hurdle. I like to think of myself as a good ball-striker, but to be honest, I really struggled with that kind of towards the end of last year and a little bit to start the year this year. So finally getting that turned around has been tough and it's been kind of a long, arduous process, but it's nice to be finally hitting it well.

Q. What's the plan? Are you going to stick around and see if it's enough?

BRANDON WU: I think hopefully anything can happen, but yeah, we'll just see.
