

ROUND 1 INTERVIEW

MIGUEL ÁNGEL JIMÉNEZ (-6)

Q. Miguel, just overall thoughts on today's round?

MIGUEL ANGEL JIMENEZ: Well, it's a very solid round, six birdies, free bogey round. Didn't play very solid all day long, no? Made a couple of shots (indiscernible) with an up-and-down, but overall did very well. From all part of my game was pretty good.

Q. Back nine run, three straight birdies right at the end of the round. What was kind of the key to catching some momentum there?

MIGUEL ANGEL JIMENEZ: Yeah, well, (indiscernible) what's nice make birdie on the hole No. 13, then par-4, birdied 15, 16, 17. Those are, especially the 13 and 14, 15, 16, those are holes that you're trying to make birdies, no? Probably the part of the golf course that you hit it closest to the green and you see probably more birdies of all the players probably.

Q. How is this course set up for scoring today versus previous times when you've been here?

MIGUEL ANGEL JIMENEZ: The golf course is very good, perfect condition. With the rain it's a little bit softer, you can attack more of the flags and the course is not playing as fast as last year, bouncing, no? But the golf course is in nice condition. A good golf course where you come and if you play well, you're going to be rewarded and if you don't play well, you going to suffer.

Q. I know you're a popular guy wherever you go, but do the fans here in Wisconsin seem to love you?

MIGUEL ANGEL JIMENEZ: Yeah, no, I mean, today a little kid with a father who like to follow me. And a lot of people, I feel like I feel comfy I with the people here. I like them, yeah, it's nice. And I like them also. (Laughs.)
