

**ROUND 2 INTERVIEW**  
**June 11, 2022**



**MIGUEL ANGEL JIMÉNEZ ( -10)**

**Q. Miguel, can you just open with your thoughts on today's round?**

**MIGUEL ANGEL JIMENEZ:** I played very solid and I start with a birdie on the first hole and then broke my driver on the second hole (indiscernible) and then I had chances to make a 5 but had a bogey. After that I've been very solid. Then birdie on hole No. 6, then birdie on the 10th and 11th, miss, then make three-putts on No. 15 where I hit a good shot second shot but not enough, hit the slope and coming all the way down, I had a very long putt, I make a bogey there. Make two birdies on 16 and 17 that allowed me to finish 10 under par. Bogeys can happen, not that we like it, but important that birdies happen (indiscernible) and I played very well and I'm happy.

**Q. Talked about it a little bit with Mark, but what do you do tonight to prepare for tonight?**

**MIGUEL ANGEL JIMENEZ:** I'm going to have a bit of wine like every night (indiscernible.) Like every night, we're going to enjoy the night and at 7:30 we have our dinner like every day. Have a cigar afterwards and go to sleep like a baby.

**Q. Couldn't hear what you said, something about your driver on 2?**

**MIGUEL ANGEL JIMENEZ:** On hole No. 2 I broke my driver. I've been hitting my driver very well, but on that hole I wanted to hit it solid over the bunker, but I blocked it and hit the ball on the right. I had to drop and still had my chances to make under par there, but make a bogey.

**Q. Have you played with Jaidee and what do you know about him?**

**MIGUEL ANGEL JIMENEZ:** I know Jaidee for a long, long time. We both played DP Tour, the European Tour and I played with him and he's a nice Thailand boy, good guy and good player.

**Q. How many pairs of shoes do you travel with?**

**MIGUEL ANGEL JIMENEZ:** Two.

**Q. And how do you decide --**

**MIGUEL ANGEL JIMENEZ:** Two. Always the black on white and my white (indiscernible.)

**Q. How do you decide which round to wear them in?**

**MIGUEL ANGEL JIMENEZ:** Gray and black or you wear white or brown or the other one. You have to match. (Indiscernible.) You know that you are connected to the world with your feet, put nice leather shoes on your feet.

**Q. These are comfortable.**

**MIGUEL ANGEL JIMENEZ:** These, too?

**Q. You were kind of in this position last year too heading into the champions group on Sunday. What do you want -- I'm sorry, I just lost the question I had, but heading into championship Sunday this time around --**

**MIGUEL ANGEL JIMENEZ:** Well, tomorrow we're going to be in the last group and tomorrow I'll just play golf and enjoy myself on the golf course and anything happens. Anything happens. There are a lot of players, very good quality of the players. Steve Flesch is playing very well. Pity for him that he make a couple bogeys to finish there. He played very solid. Thongchai played very solid, Monty is also there and there's a lot of guys there that tomorrow is another day and just keep your rhythm and play golf and anything happens.

**Q. You kind of touched on it, too. Is this a new year or are you thinking about last year, too?**

**MIGUEL ANGEL JIMENEZ:** What happened last year?

**Q. There you go.**

**MIGUEL ANGEL JIMENEZ:** We are in the present looking to the future. Past, we learn from the past.
