

**ROUND 2 INTERVIEW**  
**June 11, 2022**



**SKIP KENDALL (-3)**

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**Q. Skip, how did things go for you out there today?**

**SKIP KENDALL:** Kind of the same as yesterday. I probably played the front nine a little bit better. I think I turned in 1 under, could have been a little bit better, just again iron play is a little sketchy especially on the back side. We had a lot of opportunities out there and just wasn't really getting the ball real close. Listen, I'm happy with a couple under, 3 under total. Hopefully I can get a real good one going tomorrow.

**Q. (Inaudible.) It's been a while since you had a top-10.**

**SKIP KENDALL:** A lot, certainly. Just confirmation what I'm doing. Even though I haven't played at all, this is my first event this year, out here anyway, I'm not going to use that as an excuse. I really feel like I can play out here. Just get those irons going a little bit better tomorrow. Putting well, so never know, do some damage tomorrow.

**Q. But the way you're playing, do you want to do more events coming up?**

**SKIP KENDALL:** I'd like to, but I really don't have any status. I mean, I have the status, but it doesn't get me in any weeks. I have to rely on either Monday qualifying or hopefully maybe getting a couple more spots this year. We'll see what happens, yeah.

**Q. You wouldn't chase Mondays, though, would you?**

**SKIP KENDALL:** I don't think so. I went to the ones in the southeast, lost in a playoff in one of them to get in. It's a tough row to hoe there. That's not a fun thing. Prospects of going out and Monday qualifying every week, that's no fun, especially if I don't see myself going way out west or anything. I got too much going on at home now. But if I get in the tournaments, great, especially if I were to top-10 and get in the next one, that's even better.

**Q. Was there anything about today that was significantly better than yesterday?**

**SKIP KENDALL:** No, not really. I might have hit a couple more fairways today, I don't know, but that was about it really. It was a very similar round. Really, honestly, it was very similar, just got a little bit more out of it, obviously one shot. It's close, it's right there. I mean, I'm hoping tomorrow is going to be a low one.

**Q. The iron play, is that distance control or is that something else?**

**SKIP KENDALL:** No, you could probably call me Captain Clank this week, yeah. I was just

clanking it all over the place. A couple have been okay, but it was just a little bit of impact stuff. I'm right there. I'm hitting it good off the tee, so when you have that, you're going to have some opportunities with irons out here. I'll get it going, it's okay.

**Q. So do you want to be Professor Peer or what's the next --**

**SKIP KENDALL:** Oh, that would be nice, that would be nice instead of get rid of the clank part. Anyway, there's a lot of noise after my impacts right now, a lot of noise going on.

**Q. How much fun is this for you to be here?**

**SKIP KENDALL:** Oh, it's great.

**Q. The Wisconsinites and just everything.**

**SKIP KENDALL:** It's just great to be out seeing -- this is like a family out here so when you haven't been out in a little bit, it's nice to see the guys again. And this tour is so much fun to play. Egos are checked at the door. It's kind of come full circle. I tell people I get more dinner invitations in one day on the putting green than I would all year on the PGA Tour. Too many distractions out there, everyone's out there, you have your entourage and so much going on out there. So this is just fun. Come back full circle and we're all hanging out together, it's just a fun tour to play.

**Q. Did you go to the concert last night?**

**SKIP KENDALL:** I didn't, I didn't make that one. We had too much wine. Maybe that was the problem today. Got to quit hanging out with Dunlap, I'm blaming him.

**Q. Will you make it back to Milwaukee while you're up here?**

**SKIP KENDALL:** Probably not. I have to get back to Florida, people to teach. I'm heading back Monday morning. I wish I could go to Milwaukee. Actually, my 40 -- I shouldn't even say this probably. My 40-year reunion is today, today. I could probably make it back, but I'm not going. I could probably make it back. That would be fun.

**Q. What school?**

**SKIP KENDALL:** Nicolet High School, yeah.

**Q. Where is it being held?**

**SKIP KENDALL:** I think the Bavarian Club.

**Q. Were you voted most likely to succeed?**

**SKIP KENDALL:** No, no.

**Q. Should have been.**

**SKIP KENDALL:** I don't even think we had that. I don't even think we had that, but I'm sure I wouldn't have been.

**Q. Were you 7 when you graduated?**

**SKIP KENDALL:** What's that?
