



EMILIANO GRILLO ( -14)

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**Q. Emiliano, great finish, T-2 at the end of the day. I know there was some struggles for everybody out there, it was really difficult with the wind. I'm not going to focus on that one bad hole, you did a lot of other stuff good, but just a general assessment of your round?**

**EMILIANO GRILLO:** Yeah, obviously it's kind of hard to avoid that hole. Obviously part of the day was that little 7 I made there, but you know what, I don't think it was a bad decision. It was just made a little poor execution after the drop. You know, after today, it is what it is. I was able to -- what's important is that I was able to get it all back. I was 2 over going into nine, very difficult hole, and then I was able to make birdie on 10 and 11. I felt that I lost one there on 12, but I gained one on 13. It's one of those days.

And I have lot of positives from today, I just need to carry on the momentum. Two seconds in the last three weeks, I'll take that.

**Q. How was your reaction -- you were out there and I think Scott had a five-stroke lead at one point and you were maybe just one back of that. Then it seemed to change really rapidly with some errors that he made and Tony in the group ahead making some birdies and you were probably watching that leaderboard. Did that surprise you and did it sort of give you some more hope? Is that what was happening?**

**EMILIANO GRILLO:** Obviously I had a lot of hope going into the 14th tee. Obviously Scott made a horrible hole there and gave everybody a chance. But then just Tony pressed really hard on the gas and he just made it very hard for everybody. You know, I gave myself a chance and he just got away and I didn't -- I left every putt short. And then on 18, I was a little bit anxious and missed the putt. Obviously it didn't count for anything more than just finishing second by myself. You know, like I say, he pressed hard and I didn't, so congrats to him.

**Q. When did you start to think that maybe the tournament would be in reach for somebody other than Scott?**

**EMILIANO GRILLO:** I mean, he made three bogeys out of four holes. Obviously great birdie on 12. And then on 13 obviously he kind of opened the door again. Obviously nobody was -- nobody was expecting for him to make a big number there on the back nine, but I guess there on 13 I felt that everybody, or a few guys had a chance still.

**Q. Has this been one of the wildest front nines in a while?**

**EMILIANO GRILLO:** Definitely for me. I don't know, I guess so. I mean, you don't see big numbers on the back nine, especially from the leader, especially when you have somebody who reached 20 under par and still had more than 12 holes to go. He was playing some solid golf and then, like I say, Tony just pressed hard and he made it impossible for everybody else.

**Q. A couple of runner-up finishes in the last few weeks, what does that do for you heading into the Playoffs?**

**EMILIANO GRILLO:** Obviously it gives me what I need. I'm still debating if I'm going to play either next week or the other week. Yeah, this gives me -- it gets me what I need. I can be there, I've been there in John Deere, I've been here. It's kind of what you want, right? You want to be there in the hunt, you want to have a chance. Maybe next time I'll finish with a couple birdies and if I finish second, I'll give a little bit of trouble to whoever's leading.
