Q. Any birdies on particular holes stand out on the day?

RICKIE FOWLER: No. All the birdies, all the birdies are good. I feel like I've done a really good job of playing the par 3s well this week, which if you can score on the par 3s, kind of helps out because that's typically not an area where par 3s play a whole lot under par.

Q. Before the tournament, talked about some of the changes you made ahead of the season. Does it feel like some of those changes are paying off?

RICKIE FOWLER: Definitely. I'm still -- the last two days I wasn't exactly swinging it great. Like I said, I kind of did a good job of managing my way around. I'll get some work in tomorrow before the round and try and exaggerate a few things where I'm a little bit tighter in lines and flights that I want. Like I said, I just did a good job of accepting what I had and kind of moving forward with that.

Q. First two days have been playing pretty wet, tomorrow should be looking dry. Playing in the afternoon, what are you looking forward to?

RICKIE FOWLER: I'm assuming with being dry and after today, probably be playing the ball down, so go out and have some fun. I need to drive it well around this place, which like I said, I've managed my way with what I've had the first two days, but looking forward to a little bit of work and tighten that up. Yeah, just continue to have fun on this golf course and hopefully I'm playing from the fairway.
