Q. How would you kind of characterize the round today?

MACKENZIE HUGHES: Scrappy. Did not (inaudible). I kind of joked with Joel a little bit there that Tony had a long pro-am day today with him and I going alongside. And yeah, just felt like I was all over the lot starting out and just trying to find a way to make some pars. Was doing a good job of that for the most part. MACKENZIE HUGHES: Yeah, I think for me it's just going to the range and I'll see my coach there for a little bit and we'll just -- it's kind of the same stuff I'm working on, it's more a matter of trust than anything else. I didn't quite feel it and didn't trust it, so I'll get to the range and we'll be better tomorrow.
