

ROUND 2 INTERVIEW

CARL YUAN (-7)

Q. Carl, how would you assess the round today?

CARL YUAN: Score-wise, definitely 4 under par's really good on this course. Honestly, I wasn't hitting the ball as good. Some tee shots over the ball, I have no idea where it's going. But yeah, glad really stay in every shot, try to get around this course. I know it's a tough track that hitting greens is a key point. There will be a lot of lag putts. Fortunately I made two long ones to pick up a couple strokes there. Overall just played solid with good strategy I think, and yeah, looking forward to more of that over the weekend.

Q. How do you feel like this course is going to change a little bit if we do get a little bit of rain, the cold weather and the wind that's scheduled to come in?

CARL YUAN: Yeah, I think it will probably play a little longer, depends if the tees are moved up. I don't think the course will -- probably the greens will get a little bit softer, so probably it might be a little easier on that side. But yeah, I think still a challenge course, especially with the cold weather, balls are going shorter and just need to hit a lot of quality shots out here.

Q. After the season you had on the Korn Ferry Tour, how do you feel like your first fall on the PGA TOUR has gone for you so far?

CARL YUAN: Didn't run off a good start obviously and there's a couple things that I like to change that were the last four weeks. Took some time off and work on stuff and be able to turn my things around. Yeah, looking forward to the last one to finish off the fall.

Q. What were maybe some of the things you worked on?

CARL YUAN: Things more routine and stuff, getting over the ball, not taking too much time before hitting a shot, just more committed walking into the shot and execute it and accept the result of it.
