TYSON ALEXANDER (-8)

Q. Tyson, how would you characterize the round today in such difficult conditions?

TYSON ALEXANDER: Yeah, I was just trying to survive some holes, but there were some holes downwind that you could kind of get. But yeah, just made a bunch of pars, didn't shoot myself in the foot. Just wish I would have made a few more birdies.

Q. When you were coming into the round, what was your mentality, what was your kind of thing you were focusing on with the difficult conditions?

TYSON ALEXANDER: For me right now, I'm trying to free up my putter. I need to let it go and not try to be so careful, so I kept trying to tell myself that. And it's tough, the greens were pretty fast and it's windy, so it's hard to just let it go, but I've got to do that.

Q. Tomorrow -- right now, obviously Tony's not finished -- you're seven back of Tony. What's your mentality heading into the final round tomorrow?

TYSON ALEXANDER: Just play the best I can, just be as committed as I can to targets. I'm not going to worry about Tony, I'm going to play my game and we'll see what happens.

Q. Is there a time maybe in the round, I don't know if you're a leaderboard watcher or not, if you see maybe you're getting a little bit closer, maybe you're getting a little more aggressive or you just kind of stick to how you want to play and see how it comes out in the end?

TYSON ALEXANDER: Yeah, I think late, late in the back nine. Seven shots is a lot, so I've got to get off to a hot start. Yeah, if we get there, maybe I'll take a peek.
