

**ROUND 4 INTERVIEW**  
**November 13, 2022**



**TYSON ALEXANDER (-12)**

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**Q. Tyson, nice way to finish the week. How would you kind of characterize the week as a whole?**

**TYSON ALEXANDER:** Great week for me. I wish Tony would have taken the week off, but yeah, you know, 132 players, I think one guy's going to beat me, so that's what it's all about, just trying to beat as many people as possible.

**Q. This is going to be your best finish on Tour. What can you take from this week going forward?**

**TYSON ALEXANDER:** That I can compete. I mean, that my good -- I've said this before, my good is good. I need to do a better of it showing up maybe more often, being a little more consistent, but I was pretty calm out there. I felt like I had my good stuff, and I can compete and try to win golf tournaments out here.

**Q. How do you feel you need to become more consistent?**

**TYSON ALEXANDER:** Just being a little more meticulous probably with practice and -- that's a good question, yeah. I would just try to be a little more professional, a little more meticulous. I'm trying to get that much better, so it's splitting hairs, but I'm on my way.

**Q. I've heard a lot (inaudible) trying to get just a little bit better, that that makes a world of difference as far as the jump. Is it hard to sometimes find that little bit?**

**TYSON ALEXANDER:** Well, I also don't think that like, I don't think we're that far away, either. You know, obviously this is my first year on Tour, but I can play pretty good golf. I'm not that far off. But yeah, like I said, we're splitting hairs and it's just a fine line out here.

**Q. You talked about you are a good golfer, first year on Tour, coming in today Tony had a pretty good substantial lead, he would have to kind of throw three or four shots back for anybody really to catch him. For you to come in in second place and the fact that you birdied the last hole, just talk about that.**

**TYSON ALEXANDER:** Yeah, I'm proud of the way I hung in there today. I was trying to hit the gas today, I wasn't trying to back up or hold on. Like I said, I feel like my game is pretty good and when there's opportunities, I wanted to try to make birdies and keep going. Yeah, the birdie on the last, that's the cherry on top.

**Q. Gets a little momentum going into next year?**



**TYSON ALEXANDER:** Yeah, we've got one more week next week at Sea Island and then I get a little bit of a break, which is nice. Yeah, it's always good to feel like you're a part of the golf tournament.
