I hit some good putts I felt like didn't go in just because I misread them. Growing up in the south on bermuda greens, you can always rely on the grain. If you're confused here, there's a lot of subtle slopes. Just trying to make sure you read those properly and hit some good putts and occasionally they're going to miss, but hopefully they all fall.
