### ROUND 1 INTERVIEW

TAYLOR DICKSON (-5)



**Q. Solid first round, 5 under. Take us through your day.**

**TAYLOR DICKSON:** It was a long day with another delay this morning, but it's been a long week so far. But staying patient. We got to play golf today and luckily we had a good round.

**Q. Saw the long putt to finish on the final hole. Was it the putter today that was working for or just kind of everything?**

**TAYLOR DICKSON:** I would say it was ball-striking. Putted really well, but just had a lot of birdie putts, which was good. Didn't have to get up and down too many times except for 17 and 18. Got up and down there, saved some pars and that kind of kept the round going.

**Q. About the long delay, yesterday completely scratched and today another four-hour delay, how much does that impact any sort of mindset when you're waiting around?**

**TAYLOR DICKSON:** Not too much. It's out of our control, so you just wait around. Like I said, you've just got to be patient. There's just nothing you can do about it. Whenever they say go play, just be ready to go play. We were today, so hopefully we'll be ready tomorrow.

**Q. Have you played in 54-hole tournaments before?**

**TAYLOR DICKSON:** No, no, I haven't. Maybe mini tours, but other than that, no.

**Q. Do you think going into it knowing that you only have 54, is there any sort of like increased aggressiveness at a certain point?**

**TAYLOR DICKSON:** No, no, just still trying to get as many birdie chances as I can and hopefully make as many of them as I can, just stay aggressive. But however many holes there are, that's out of my control, too. Just need to go out there and play well and just have a chance on the back nine hopefully.

**Q. How do you think the course held up with all the water?**

**TAYLOR DICKSON:** It's a little wet, but nothing you can do about it. Just rain, fog, everything's a little damp, but course is in good shape, the greens are still really good. Just got to deal with it. Everybody's dealing with it.
