Q. Three birdies on your last three holes today, Brandon, overall great round. How were you able to finish so strong?

BRANDON WU: Yeah, I think wind probably laid down just a little bit at the end there. The holes are still playing long and tough. I think I hit 4-iron into 16 and 5-iron into 17, but luckily hit some good iron shots, made the putts to make birdie, so that was a nice way to finish.

Q. You mentioned to me earlier this week that you're trying to lower your ball flight a little bit to help with dealing with the wind. How much has that helped you out here on this golf course?

BRANDON WU: Yeah, I think every driver I teed pretty low just to kind of keep it under the wind, get it running a little bit. Yeah, I think it's been good. I've definitely been driving it well so far this week, so I think got to keep that up this weekend.

Q. Still looking for that first PGA TOUR win. Heading into the weekend, what kind of mindset are you trying to come into it with?

BRANDON WU: Yeah, I think just focus on myself, play my own game. I really enjoy the course, there's plenty of birdies out there, so if I can just focus on staying within myself, not getting too caught up in trying to win my first time or whatever, I think I can have a good weekend.

Q. Obviously draining a few putts left and right out there, but where do you feel most confident in your game right now, what part of your game?

BRANDON WU: I think everything's felt pretty good. I think yesterday my short game kept me afloat. I missed a lot of greens. Just be able to chip it close and make a few putts, definitely have putted well as well. You can hit it close, but you've got to roll it in to make birdie, so I think that felt really good, too.
