Q. Brandon, I know not as low as you wanted to go today. How do you assess the way things turned out?

BRANDON WU: Yeah, I think I was happy with the round overall. I knew I needed to make a lot of birdies and maybe a couple eagles to have any chance of catching the leaders. I feel like I was able to do that, but just a few too many loose swings. Satisfied with how I went today, I'm glad I gave myself a chance through nine holes and yeah, solid week.

Q. Yeah, you were off to a great start, had some good momentum going there that kind of died at the 8th and a little bit at the 10th as well, one of the toughest holes out here. How hard was it for you to kind of mentally bounce back from that the last nine holes?

BRANDON WU: Yeah, I think that 10th tee shot was maybe a few bad swings in a row. It's tough, you've got to really hunker down and trust your swing, trust that you've been hitting good shots all week. I think I did a good job of that. Luckily, scored well I think on 12 and 13, made some nice putts. Yeah, it was a tough kind of stretch there, but I'm glad I made it through it.

Q. Still, a great performance for you this week. What kind of confidence does this give you going into the rest of the season and also just the experience of being in the hunt on Sunday?

BRANDON WU: Yeah, for sure. I think going toe to toe with two of the best players in the world is good, it's great experience, good to kind of feel the emotions, know how to stay calm in the moment and stay focused on myself. Yeah, I think it was a great experience and glad to have done it.
