JERRY KELLY: Make as many birdies if you can. If you don't, there's no rally, that's it. Try and make eagles, try and make birdies. First I've got to go find it or I'm not going to make another birdie.

Q. Justin thought that the afternoon, based on his practice rounds, the afternoon groups might see a little tougher conditions in terms of the greens and putting. Did you feel that at all and do you think that maybe going off early --

JERRY KELLY: It's only a two-hour window, that doesn't make any difference. No, it's not like a morning wave, afternoon wave, it's not like the pro-am was.

It was fine. I left everything short, it was much -- I think it was slower than yesterday. But yeah, I didn't hit the fairways, didn't hit the greens, didn't hit the putts, didn't hit the chips. It's awesome.
