TYLER DUNCAN (-11)



Q. Bogey free heading into the weekend, what are your thoughts?

TYLER DUNCAN: For sure. Nice to finish. And then they have dinner here for us, I forgot all about that. I got off the cart and walked to the corner and I was like, yes, they have dinner, so that made my night.

Q. What will be your key thoughts going into tomorrow?

TYLER DUNCAN: Not a whole lot. I definitely was a little shaky with the putter today, I wasn't too happy with how I felt out there. Just try to figure out how to clear the mind a little bit on the greens and see if I can make some putts.
