J.T. POSTON (-10)



Q. J.T., second consecutive nice round for you. Just what's kind of worked well for two rounds?

J.T. POSTON: Game's just been solid overall. I think yesterday the putter was kind of the difference maker. It was playing pretty tough with the wind that we had in the afternoon and I just had one of those days where I felt like I couldn't miss, so it was a good time to do that. Today was just really solid I felt like. Obviously bogey free, which is nice. Yeah, game just feels like it's in a good place.

Q. Curious how the energy's holding up after the long flight and getting back over here now?

J.T. POSTON: Yeah, it's been a little bit of an adjustment and something I've definitely been paying attention to. Haven't really spent too much time on the range, practice rounds and pro-am were pretty minimal. Just trying to save energy and get back on this time zone. Today's probably the first day that it's really felt back to normal. Yesterday was pretty close, but I think today I feel a lot better.

Q. Are you looking forward to the weekend now? If you're feeling good now, maybe Saturday, Sunday, maybe even a little bit better?

J.T. POSTON: Yeah, I feel like I'm back to normal now. This weekend should be no problem. Definitely looking forward to it.

Q. What are you liking about the setup or the course this week that you've been playing so well?

J.T. POSTON: You know, I think it fits my eye. I think you've got to drive it well. The greens are really good. They're bentgrass, what I grew up on, so very comfortable on these types of greens. I don't know, something about them, I just feel like I have a pretty good feel and can read them really well and so I've always putted pretty well.

Q. Has the course softened at all with the overnight rains we've had the last couple nights?

J.T. POSTON: I would say it's about the same as yesterday. It is definitely soft. I think you're going to see -- I mean, the ball's pretty much stopping right where it lands on the greens regardless of what club you're hitting and wedges are spinning. It's pretty gettable. You're going to see some low scores this afternoon probably if the wind doesn't blow. Yeah,



I think we're in for some birdies the rest of the week.

- Q. Sixtieth I think coming into this week in the FedExCup rankings, kind of right in between making the top-70 but also the top-50 from BMW. How are you just kind of managing that spot and both trying to make it to FedExCup but also the BMW?
- **J.T. POSTON:** Yeah, I mean, a few weeks ago I was 85th so I was trying to just string together some good weeks. Played really well at the John Deere, played well again at Scottish and had a decent week last week at The Open. So just kind of been riding a nice wave of momentum of good golf. Like I said, my game feels like it's in a good spot, so I'm just trying to go play well and just see where it stacks up when the Playoffs get here.
- Q. You've had a couple seasons where you catch fire a little bit in the summertime, play well kind of later in the season. Is there anything to why that happens?
- **J.T. POSTON:** You know, I have no idea, but it's definitely a trend, I guess. I guess it's a good thing. I'd rather play well at the end of the year than at the beginning and then kind of coast. I don't know, I don't know if it's just the golf courses at the end of the year fit my eye a little bit better or I'm used to playing in the heat. I don't really know, but trying to keep it going.
