Q. Dylan, nice way to finish. What was it, 64?

DYLAN WU: Yeah.

Q. Just talk about that round a little bit and what it does for you going forward here?

DYLAN WU: Yeah, for sure. Played well yesterday, shot 4 under. Felt like today was going to be similar to yesterday where I was going to have to stay patient and grind. I know scores were going to be low just with the good weather.

Got off to a good start, birdied the first couple holes, which was nice. I've had a lot of good this year in my second year on Tour, just kind of been struggling on the back nine on Sunday. I can think of like four, five tournaments. So to shoot 7 under and play well on the back nine, especially when I'm up there not feeling like I have the greatest -- my greatest game especially with an off week, it feels great for me just to finish a tournament off.

Q. Just coming in here No. 103 in the FedExCup standings like into the week, and I think you were in the alternate list for next week, so the chance to finish in the top-10 this week, maybe play next week, would your plan be to obviously go there?

DYLAN WU: Yeah, for sure. Like the mini goal was try and make the Playoffs, which is top-70. I was in the 90 to 110 spot where like you're still, you want to play well enough so you don't have to play that much in the fall because you want to guarantee the top-25. So luckily, playing well here helps me get closer to that top-70 number moving up the FedEx. I'm glad I can play next week. I signed up for the Monday qualifier, I had a flight today at 8:15 to Charlotte and I was going to drive to Greensboro, so I'm glad I don't have to do that. I'm looking forward to playing at Sedgefield next week and hopefully playing well, trying to make the Playoffs and make a little run.

Q. When you say you're glad you don't have to do that, can you express that, like how does that change your whole dynamic into next week?

DYLAN WU: Yeah, it's just so nice knowing you're in the tournament. I'm in the 126-to-150 category this year and I've got into a lot of tournaments and played my way into some bigger events, but the one thing is I have to keep on checking field lists, which is not the most fun. That's the one thing next season I'll really like because I'll know the tournaments I'll get into.

Yeah, I've done it in the past. I remember in Puntacana this year I was first alternate after I finished, I missed finishing in the top-10 by one shot. I went from Puntacana all the way to



San Antonio, Texas, flew through Dallas, got there like 3:00 a.m., drove three hours and had a tee time at 9:30. Ended up getting in on my number, but like that stuff, I don't have to do that tonight, which is nice. It's all part of the grind and just glad to be in the tournament next week.
