

ADAM SCOTT (-12)

Q. Adam, you knew you needed a low round to have a chance. Obviously 63, you get that done. Kind of what was your mindset heading in?

ADAM SCOTT: I didn't really have one, honestly. I didn't play well on Friday and Saturday tee to green, didn't feel amazing, so I didn't really have any expectations. That might have been a good thing for a good score. I wish I knew what I was doing, but I don't.

Q. Are you planning to sit around and watch and kind of see where it ends up?

ADAM SCOTT: Yeah. I mean, it's close, actually it's close right now. So I don't want to get my hopes up, but there's a chance. I think if the wind stays around, the greens are very, very spicy out there, so it's not easy to nestle it up near the hole and get the ball in the hole. If it was a little easier out there, I'd say it has no chance, but you never know.

Q. Adam, do you have plane tickets to two different places right now?

ADAM SCOTT: Yeah, I'll just wait and see what happens. Fortunately I don't have to rush home if I need to get home.

Q. Did you think about it on the par putt out there, the last one?

ADAM SCOTT: I honestly, I thought I was too -- you know, there's so many people close just behind me with a lot of holes to go. It's likely I'll finish about 9th or 10th or something, I think.

Q. Does the streak mean something to you? It's obviously an easy thing for us to talk about because it exists. Does it register for you? Would you be sad more to have missed the Playoffs or to have lost the streak?

ADAM SCOTT: I think I'm actually getting to the point where, you know, I've got to put that stuff aside and, you know, not play to keep a streak of playing Playoffs going but play to win stuff, not just be there to make the numbers up.

So if it does end, I think it's a good thing. I think it gives me a good chance to have a look at what I need to do differently to be more competitive in whatever competition I'm playing in.

Q. If you don't make it, where do you think you'll play next?

ADAM SCOTT: I always play the Japan Open every year, so I'll be there.
