CAM DAVIS

Q. Cam, how difficult was it?

CAM DAVIS: It was -- that was one of the windiest rounds of golf I've had all year, for sure. That was tough.

Q. Can you describe like any particular hole where the club difference was just a couple of club differences?

CAM DAVIS: Well, I hit my shortest drive of the year probably by 40 yards on the last hole. I can remember the last time I hit driver, driver on a par-4 and still came up short of the green. It was a really tough day. Very happy with the way I grinded it out in even par because that felt like a really difficult round.

Q. Two birdies in the last four holes, that must have been nice coming in.

CAM DAVIS: Yeah. I mean, even if I turned in 2 over, that still would have been fine, but to get back to even par, I feel really proud of that. I can't remember the last time we played with like a four- or five-club wind. It's been a long time for me.

Q. This is like a continuation of your fine form. What has been working really well for you the last few months, Cam?

CAM DAVIS: Honestly, the patience. I used it again today. Things weren't going super well, but I just stuck with it and kept on giving myself chances and eventually a couple went. I mean, most parts of my game have been pretty solid, so today kind of threw it around a little bit. It was hard to hit fairways, hard to hit greens, but just grinding it out and staying patient once again helped me get a few shots less than what I might have otherwise. So I would say that kind of thinking in this sort of conditions is the best thing you can do.

Q. Excited for the weekend ahead?

CAM DAVIS: Of course, yeah. I hope it's not quite this windy, but I'm looking forward to it.

Q. It feels like most of the board is either even or over par today. How good is Beau's 5 under today? How crazy is that?

CAM DAVIS: I wouldn't have said 5 under was out there, but obviously these guys are pretty damn good. I mean, you always expect someone to have a day where things go their way and obviously Beau has just played super great golf. Hats off to him. I managed to keep

myself within shouting distance, I guess, so from now on, hopefully if it's not quite this bad weather-wise, there's going to be a lot of birdies out there. Still got 36 holes there to try and chase him down.
