CAM DAVIS: Well, if the weather stays like it was today, then yeah, definitely someone will be able to get hot. It's a matter of making the putts. Eric in my group today made most of his putts and turned in a very good score. So yeah, I'm going to need something like that.

Q. Do you feel like your game is firing on every front?

CAM DAVIS: For me, I feel like once I'm in the fairway, things have been going pretty well. Yeah, it's just off the tee was a little bit rough today, but if that's clean tomorrow, then hopefully it's just a matter of a few putts dropping rather than lipping out.

Q. Presume it's the same game plan even though you're going to try to chase for the lead in the final round?

CAM DAVIS: No, we just take every shot for what it is out here. We try not to get too sucked into trying to be too aggressive or too conservative if things are going very well. Just figure out what we have in front of us and figure out what's the play now. Just keep it simple.
