HARRISON FRAZAR (-11, won 1st playoff hole)

HARRISON FRAZAR: Yeah, 16.

Q. Right, 16. How important was that little 75-yarder?

HARRISON FRAZAR: I was mad at myself. I can reach that hole with that wind if I hit a good 3-wood and a hybrid and I just whiffed it. That's my bread and butter, that's my favorite club. So missing it at that time kind of irritated me.

But hitting that wedge shot up there close, I was just trying to get it to land somewhere on the bottom and bounce up there six, eight, 10 feet right, but to get up there close is nice.
