Yeah, this week I feel like I started not too fast, it was quite slow, and then the weekend I got going. Yeah, this week has been really good, too. Just happy to move on and get my card.

Q. Talk about second shot on the first hole. That must have been nice.

MIN WOO LEE: Yeah, it wasn't a really good number and it was a shot that I was kind of struggling with. It was like a very soft gap wedge, but it comes out really hot. Just really, again, I really committed to just trying to hit it soft and it came out just so beautiful. One bounce and it went in, so really happy with that. Hopefully they got that on camera.

Q. Where do you go from here? You've got quite a few more to go before the year's up?

MIN WOO LEE: Yeah. Well, if a top-10 gets into Cabo, so I'll have to see with my team if I'll play that, but right now I'm committed to playing in Europe finishing off the year there.
