Q. Ben, just talk a little bit about your comfort level on this course right now. I think that's your 10th straight round in the 60s here at Sedgefield.

I don't think there's much of an advantage hitting it far on this golf course. I guess tee to green. You know, has very severe greens that I guess that helps in hitting a lot of greens and making a lot of birdies.

Q. And just anecdotally, it seems like a lot of guys on the leaderboard that have played well here in the past are doing well. Do you think there's any reason for that or just coincidence?

BYEONG HUN AN: That's weird. I'll let you know why, but it's good confidence to have going into this event. I see a lot of the good finishers out here, historically they have good finishes every year. I've had some decent finishes, I feel pretty comfortable hitting the ball out of the bermudagrass. So yeah, if I can keep this going for the weekend.
