

J.T. POSTON (-7)

Q. J.T., how would you kind of characterize the round today?

J.T. POSTON: Really good tee to green. I really hit my irons good and gave myself a lot of looks, but it felt like all those looks were kind of downhill sliders, so I really struggled with the putter. Two under was about as bad as it felt like I was going to shoot the way I hit it.

Q. Was it line, speed, just the type of putts you had that you weren't that comfortable?

J.T. POSTON: I mean, Webb and I were just talking about in scoring. It's just hard, the greens were fast especially when you get above the hole. Just felt like I hit a lot of good shots, but I kept leaving myself these 10-, 12-, 8-footers that were playing -- I mean, you're playing pretty far outside the hole with the right speed. It's not really putts you feel like you can be aggressive with and bang in the back of the cup. I'm going to go work on it and try and get the putter hot for the weekend, but overall it was a decent round.

Q. What do you feel like's been the biggest key over the last let's say month or so to your good play?

J.T. POSTON: The ball-striking's really come around. I think kind of early in the year I didn't chip or putt it that great either, everything was just kind of average. Really worked hard on the chipping and putting and I think that sort of freed up the ball-striking, too.

Last month it seems like it's all kind of clicked, gave myself a lot of looks like I did today and just in the past I've been making a few more than today.

Q. J.T., it's going to be soft on the weekend. Do you expect to have really low scores Saturday and Sunday?

J.T. POSTON: Yeah. Like I said, the greens are rolling really good. They're fast, so if you're above the hole, it makes it a little trickier. But they're rolling so pure, guys are going to be able to make putts if you hit it in the right spots. The softness is just going to pretty much let it play like a birdie-fest.

Q. When you're playing like you are right now, does it feel like doesn't matter what course you go to, you feel like you can contend to win the golf tournament?

J.T. POSTON: Yeah, I feel like I've got really good control of my golf ball right now. So places that yield a lot of birdies, I feel like I can be aggressive and I can hit it close to the



hole. Places where it's a little tougher, I feel like I've got control to hit it in the right spots. Yeah, I have a lot of confidence in my game right now and just trying to keep it going.
